

PENGUIN SKI CLUB
Lodge Rules and Regulations

1. **Safety**
 - a. No smoking allowed in the Lodge.
 - b. Do not allow persons into the club if they are not known to you – no grand tours of the lodge under any circumstances.
 - c. Possession or use of illegal substances is not permitted on club property.
 - d. No weapons are permitted on club property.
 - e. No fighting is permitted on club property.
 - f. Minors are forbidden to partake of alcoholic beverages on the premises. Violation of this rule will mean automatic expulsion from the club. Adults furnishing alcoholic beverages to minors will automatically be expelled from the club.

2. **Reservations, Room Assignments, Use of Lodge**
 - a. Reservations are required at all times. Reservations must be canceled. Cancel weekend reservations during ski season by calling the lodge.
 - b. Members and Guests must register immediately upon arrival and pay nightly rate fees.
 - c. Associate members and guests may not use the Lodge unless accompanied by a Lodge or General member.
 - d. Members will be held accountable for their conduct, as well as that of their guests and visitors, while on club property.
 - e. Guests are forbidden to stay at the lodge unless accompanied by a club member over 21 years of age. Children under the age of 16 require an adult member supervising at all times.
 - f. No men are allowed in women's rooms, no women are allowed in men's rooms – unless assigned by Lodge Committee.
 - g. More than four guests per voting member will be considered a group and requires advanced notice for approval by the Board of Directors.
 - h. Children must be potty trained and are required to sleep in a bunk bed.

3. **Ski Equipment**
 - a. Ski boots are not to be worn inside the lodge beyond the kitchen. Boots may be left in the hallway
 - b. All ski equipment must be stored in the ski room only.
 - c. Use ski room door for all ski equipment.

4. **Courtesy**
 - a. Excessive noise will not be tolerated between 11:00 PM and 8:00 AM.
 - b. Be considerate of other people sleeping. No yelling or talking loudly on the second floor at all times.
 - c. Be reasonably quiet after midnight. Volume on radio, Tape and CD player, and TV should be lowered.
 - d. Respect other people's property. Leave bunks as you found them. Under no circumstances are members or guests to use another person's sleeping bag or personal belongings.
 - e. Responsibility should be shared – help keep the club clean by washing dishes, emptying waste baskets, leave bathrooms and bunk rooms clean, and as needed general pick-up.
 - f. No running in the Lodge.
 - g. Adults should be given priority to sleep on lower bunks.

- h. Members and guests are responsible for complete clean up of their sleeping quarters and any facilities they may use (including washing of dirty dishes.)
 - i. No men are allowed in women's rooms, no women are allowed in men's rooms – unless assigned by Lodge Committee.
 - j. Children should stay in assigned bunk rooms and only go into other member's rooms when invited.
 - k. Minors are not to participate in adult after-ski activities in the rec room.
5. **Snow Removal & Shoveling**
- a. Shovels are available on the back porch – *responsibility should be shared* – shovel out the porch stairs and entrance to the Ski Room.
 - b. Please be sure your car keys are available to move your car during plowing operation.
6. **Thermostats & Hot Water** – on weekends the hot water is regulated by a timer. The heat will be regulated by the LODGE CHAIRPERSON ONLY. Do not touch either unit on weekends. Instructions are posted to operate during weekdays. Use the buttons on the outside, never open the cover.
7. **SHOWERS** – On Saturday & Sunday mornings and holiday weeks showers are NOT to be taken between 6:00 and 9:00 am. Consideration should be given to members & guests waiting for bathrooms during this time period – GET IN AND GET OUT.
8. **Personal food and beverages** – should be labeled with name and date and kept in the refrigerators in the Rec. Room and taken home if not used. **FOOD AND BEVERAGES ARE NOT TO BE KEPT IN BUNK ROOMS.**
9. **Shut and Lock all Windows & Doors** – including the Ski Room when leaving the Lodge. Make sure gas stove dials are off and lights in the house are shut off including parking lot and Penguin sign. During weekdays, make sure the hot water heater switch is turned off.
10. Nightly stays are not to exceed 10 consecutive days without Board approval. Extended stays also require Board approval.

Failure to abide by the above rules and regulations will result in disciplinary action by the Board of Directors.
